



Every type of angler is catered for in the area. For the sea angler Luce Bay is one of the finest Tope grounds in Britain and Loch Ryan offers good protection in most weather. Charter boats are available from Stranraer or Luce Bay. For the Coarse angler there are waters to catch Carp, Pike and Perch not too far away.

Golfers have a good choice of Stranraer Golf Course only two miles away and Dunksey Golf Course and putting at Portpatrick.

Meet Copper and Daisy our pet goats, a great attraction for all the family.

There is an excellent pony trekking stable three quarters a mile away. The quiet roads and woodland tracks provide an ideal way to view the countryside.

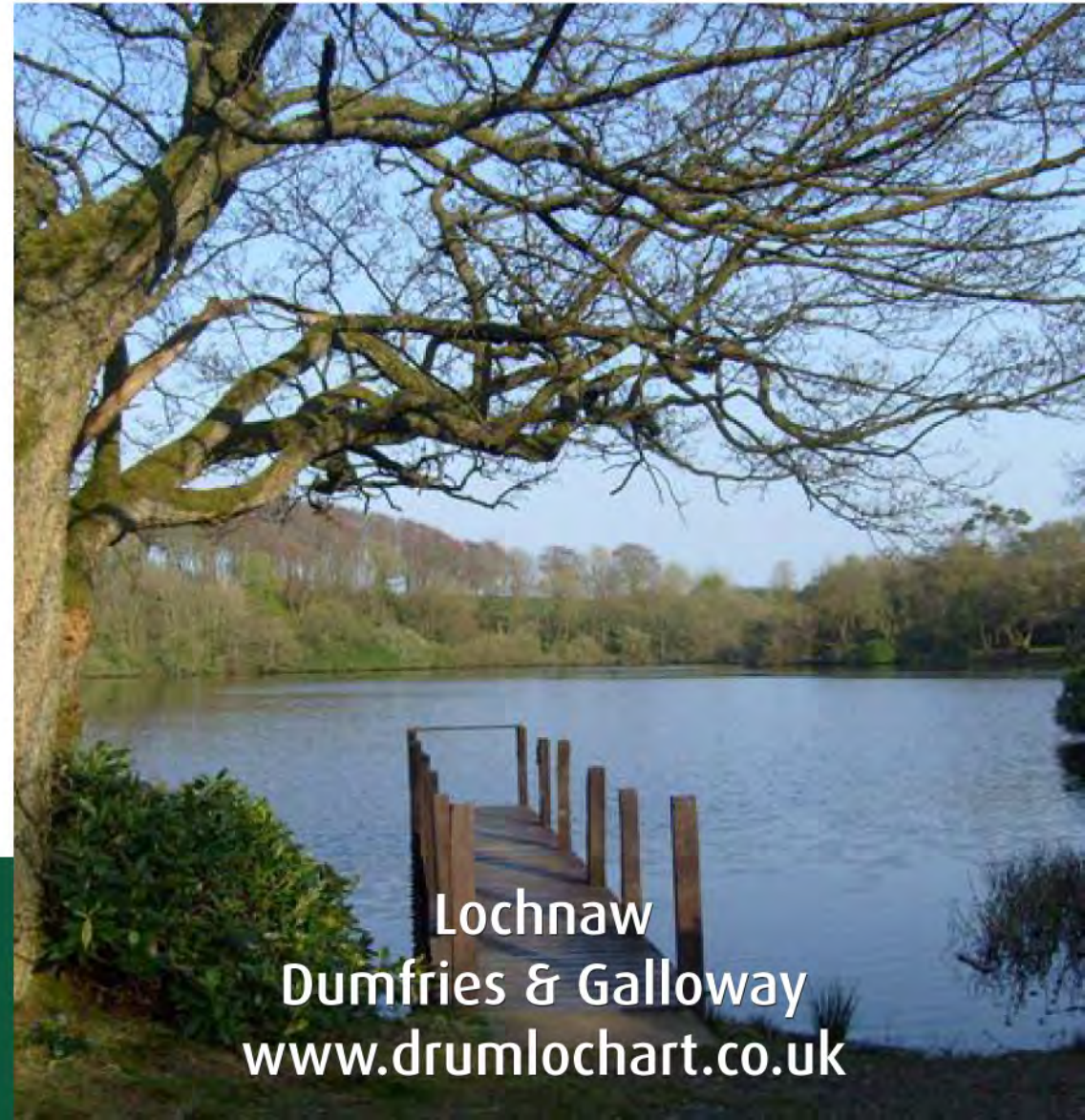
The leisure centre at Stranraer provides many activities including a main swimming pool and a 60-meter waterslide, cinema and theatre, games hall and fitness room.



Directions to Drumlochart:-

From Dumfries on A75, turn right on entering Stranraer signed Kirkcolm and harbour. Turn left onto A718 at the "T" junction, at roundabout take road straight across signed Kirkcolm, continue to Leswalt (2.5 miles). Turn left at the church (B7043) on entering Leswalt. Drumlochart is on your right after 1.5 miles.

From Ayr on A77 follow road around Loch Ryan to Stranraer and continue to Leswalt on A718 as above.

Drumlochart is a family owned park situated in an area of outstanding natural beauty, set in 22 acres of mixed woodland with clearings edged with Rhododendron hedges giving privacy and shelter. The spaciousness of the park provides a wonderful area of exploration. Although in the heart of the countryside, Drumlochart is only four miles from the port of Stranraer and eight miles from the fishing village of Portpatrick.

We have a wide selection of new and pre-owned holiday homes for sale to suit all budgets. Touring and motor caravans are well catered for with hard standing sites and grass areas for awnings and car parking. We have modern



toilet facilities including hairdryers and free hot showers, there is also a separate dishwashing area. The laundry including washing machines, sink washing, tumble dryer and ironing facilities is for all to use.

We do allow dogs on the park as long as they are kept on a lead at all times.

The surrounding area is a gardeners dream; since the climate is influenced by the Gulf Stream. There are several renowned gardens nearby. These include Castle Kennedy, Ardwell, Glenwhan and possibly the best known Logan Gardens. Not to be missed also is Soleburn Garden Centre three miles away.

Many places of historical interest are just a short drive away; the Archaeological Dig at 'Whithorn', Culzean Castle and Country Park.

Day excursions depart from Stranraer Harbour and Cairnryan, by high speed ferries and coaches give excellent tours to Ireland visiting the Old Bushmills distillery, Giants Causeway, Mountains of Mourne, also Belfast Zoo and shopping trips.

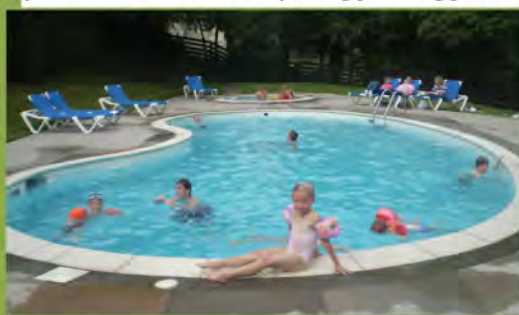


Aldouran Lounge provides a perfect place to meet for a quiet friendly drink. Adjoining the Aldouran the Lounge is a family room

The 'Black Loch' set in a beautiful woodland setting is only 200 yards along one of the park's woodland walks, where you may see wildlife including badgers, roe deer, red squirrels, buzzards, swans, herons and kingfishers.

The heated swimming pool is located in a very sheltered suntrap position. The pool opens July and August, and for toddlers there is an adjoining paddling pool.
